



21st Annual Valencia HS Field "Classic" Saturday, October 15, 2011

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

Arrival:

Valencia High School is located at 500 N. Bradford Ave., Placentia. See map for detailed directions. All buses/trucks will be in one Kraemer MS lot on Angelina St. (see map) where you will be met by hosts. The tournament hosts will stamp the hands of all participants while buses/trucks proceed to the assigned spaces in the participant parking area. Spectator parking is available off Bradford Ave, near the stadium (see map). Please observe all city parking regulations. Limited handicapped parking is available on campus.

Check-In:

Upon arrival, you will be greeted by a parent host and student guides who will give you your check-in packet including wristbands for your staff. You will then be directed to parking and warm-up areas.

THERE ARE NO DRESSING OR STORAGE FACILITIES PROVIDED. EACH BAND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ITS EQUIPMENT. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME.

Security:

We are in need of your assistance to ensure the safety of your group's belongings stored on buses and equipment vehicles. Remember that buses left unattended may be prone to damage and theft. We must issue this disclaimer for all buses and accompanying vehicles:

The Placentia-Yorba Linda USD, Valencia High School Administration or Valencia Instrumental Parents cannot be held responsible to replace lost or stolen items.

Tickets:

Every spectator attending the tournament is required to purchase admission. Spectator admission is **\$10.00 for adults and \$8.00 for students/seniors**. Children 5 and under are free.

NOTE FOR PARENTS AND FRIENDS ATTENDING: Our school district policy prohibits patrons from bringing containers or coolers into the stadium. Please notify your group of this policy.

Food Service:

The Valencia Instrumental Parents will have a full menu of food and drink items that we would encourage your students and parents to support. *All directors and staff are invited to join us for a complimentary meal in the hospitality room (location on campus map)*

BAR-BE-QUE'S AND TAILGATING ARE NOT PERMITTED ON ANY PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA USD PARKING/SCHOOL AREA.

This is a fundraising event for the Valencia High School Tiger Regiment. Please encourage your students and parents to eat at our concessions. A pre-order menu is available in your information packet.

SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED ON ANY PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED CAMPUS.

First Aid:

We will have a first aid tent set-up just outside the performers exit-gate in the stadium. Please bring with you all emergency forms so that your students can receive any necessary medical attention. Each band is the primary care provider for their students. Our first aid station is for obtaining emergency care only. In the event that a student needs to go to first aid, it is imperative that an adult remains with the student.

FIELD SHOW INFORMATION

Warm Up Area:

All playing must be done on the Kraemer athletic fields or on their courts. Playing is not permitted in the bus area because of the close proximity to neighboring homes and the stadium. *Ultimately each director is responsible to move the group out of the warm-up area at the assigned times.* **Please face your band away from the stadium while warming up. Local Rule: Bands who are interfering with a performing group will be warned only ONCE before being assessed a 1.0 penalty. No drums are allowed while marching to the staging area.**

Staging Area:

The staging area is a **SILENT AREA**. There must be no playing while in this area. The Final Staging Area is inside of the track fence on the southeast (visitors side) corner of the stadium. **Field equipment and crew should be ready on the south end of the stadium (near the snack bar) track 15 minutes before your performance.**

Field Deployment:

The stadium announcer will announce, “_____ High School, you may take the field.” You may begin to move your band/auxiliary onto the field at this time. You will then be given a 3-minute warning and a 1-minute warning at which time the official SCSBOA tournament announcer will read the announcement script.

Time Limits:

All shows must be a minimum of 7 minutes and a maximum of 11 minutes. There will be a one-point penalty for each 30 seconds or fraction thereof for overtime or under time performances. Timing will end when all personnel **and equipment** have cleared the front sideline or goal line. **SILENT CADENCE PLEASE!** A one-point penalty will be assessed for interference that disturbs the group entering the field.

Competition and Adjudication:

Timing and adjudication will begin immediately following the announcement
“_____ High School, the judges are ready”

The Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association will adjudicate the tournament. The tournament will employ one head judge, 4 band judges (two music, one general effect, and one visual), and one auxiliary judge.

Announcer:

All announcements, pre-show and post-show, will be made by the official tournament announcer. The official SCSBOA show announcement script (included with your application) will be used for all competing bands. If you need an extra script sheet you can download at <http://www.scsboa.org/events.html>

Admission/Chaperones:

Students and designated chaperones (with hand stamp) have free admission to **the performers seating section (visitors side) only**. Students and chaperones will be stamped on buses. Chaperones are requested to stay with and supervise their students in the stands.

Staff Entry:

7 Wristbands will be provided for staff of **your** unit and 1 videographer wristband will be provided.

Perusal Period:

Prior to the awards being announced you will be given a 5-minute perusal period. Please use this time to tally your scores and check for errors. Once the 5 minutes are up, all judges will be released and all results are final. Any discrepancies in numbers prior to the awards being read should be brought to the attention of the Head Judge (Mr. Phil Mortensen). There are NO critiques at SCSBOA Field Tournaments.

Awards Presentation:

The Valencia Classic has two awards ceremonies: one for 1A/2A/3A bands and one for 4A/5A/6A. All bands will be awarded and one set of Sweepstakes trophies will be given for the top score in Music, G.E., Visual, Colorguard, Percussion and overall Band at each of the two tournaments.

Rain Policy:

In the event of rain the show will continue. If the skies are clear and the field is just unsafe to march on, we will do a stand still performance on the track and all captions will be adjudicated. If it is raining cats and dogs, we will move the event in the Gymnasiums. One gym will be a holding/warm-up area and the other will be the performance area. Because trophies, programs, and food have already been purchased, no refunds will be given. We are also contracted to disperse "report pay" to the 8 adjudicators. **Scores will not count towards SCSBOA Championship qualifying in the event of a rainout!**

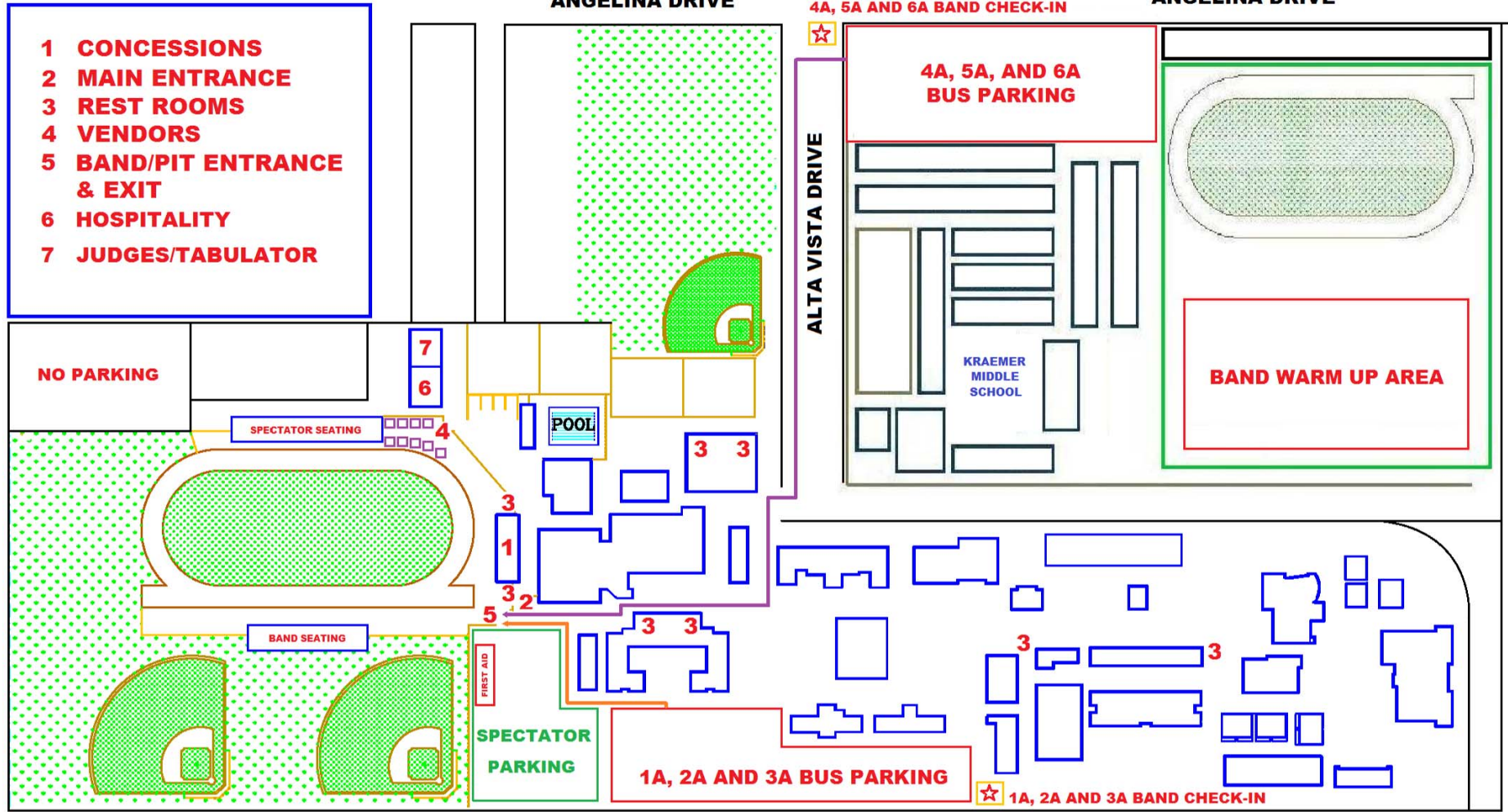
